Facilities and Services Available to Students with Disabilities

Woodruff Medical and Wellness Training does not discriminate on the basis of disability. Individuals with disabilities are entitled to a reasonable accommodation to ensure that they have full and equal access to the educational resources of the institution, consistent with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. § 794) ("Section 504") and the Americans with Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. § 12182) ("ADA") and their related statutes and regulations. Section 504 prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability in any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance. The ADA prohibits a place of public accommodation from discriminating on the basis of disability. The applicable law and regulations may be examined in the office of the Campus Director, who has been designated to coordinate the efforts of the institution to comply with Section 504 and ADA.

STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES: Students with disabilities will be accepted for enrollment provided they meet all the requirements to complete their program. No adjustment will be made to the curriculum to compensate for a student's disability. However, all facilities are handicapped accessible. If there is an unmet need that we can remedy, please contact the campus director or program director at each campus during regular business hours to discuss reasonable accommodations to make our schools a more comfortable environment for all people.
